## Study Design - Overview

 Discuss proposal with local Zambian partners and solicit input and participation

July 2012

Collect and analyze baseline data

August 12- Jan 13

 Train participants for intervention, prepare materials and conduct intervention

February 13

Collect and anlyze followup data

March 13- August 13

 Join with local partners in making recommendations for improvements

Every 12 month




#### **Actions undertaken**

- Briefing of partner's staff on coordinated victim assistance
- Network meetings (every year)
- Printed materials/information (posters, brochures, pocket cards)
- Medical students of Zambia and Austria involved

### 174 persons included in the study




# Lapse of time between the injuries and consultation/ treatment

- The average lapse of time between the incident and the time of the medical treatment was about 28,5 hours.
- For 7 of 11 <u>severely</u> injured patients: It was between 30 minutes and 11 days (arithmetic mean: 29 hours).





### Location of Violence





"Have you received sufficient information on community services?"



















"Have you received sufficient information how to contact and reach medical and community services?"








"How concerned are you about receiving appropriate help later on in the case of discomfort and need?"










HOW TO CONTINUE WITH THIS PROJECT?
